When: Sunday, March 8th, 2015. Doors open at 7am, wrestling begins at 9 AM

Weigh-ins: Saturday, March 7, 6 – 8 PM,
Sunday, March 8, 7 – 7:45 AM,

Wrestlers **MUST** weigh-in in a singlet.

Registration: \$25 with a current NYWAY Membership. **Online registration only** closes 11:59pm on Thursday, March 6th, 2015. NYWAY Memberships can be purchased online. Payments must be made at www.nyway.org.

Admission: \$3 for Adults, \$1 for children over the age of 5. 5 & under and senior citizens are FREE.

Awards: Top 4 finishers receive a medal and T-Shirt.

Divisions & weights:

D1 (2009/2008): 37, 40, 43, 46, 50, 55, 60, 65, 72, 79, HWT (Max 90)

D2 (2007/2006): 43, 47, 51, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 82, 90, 98, 108, HWT (Max 120)

D3 (2005/2004): 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 105, 115, 125, HWT (Max 145)

D4 (2003/2002): 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 98, 105, 113, 121, 130, 140, 155, HWT (Max 175)

D5 (2001/2000): 81, 87, 93, 99, 105, 111, 118, 125, 132, 139, 146, 153, 160, 170, 185, HWT (Max 220)

D6* (1999 – 1996): Wrestlers will be paired using the Madison Style Pairing System at the Regional Tournament, but HS weight classes will be used at the State Tournament.

*Wrestlers born in 99 must compete in this group at Regional and State regardless of their grade level.

***EXEMPTIONS – JV/Varsity Wrestlers automatically qualify for the NYWAY State Tournament in Ithaca, NY, but are still encouraged to participate in their Regional Tournaments. The \$17 NYWAY Membership is required for all wrestlers at the Regional and State Tournaments.**

Rules:

- All divisions will be determined by birth year.
- NYS Modified High School Rules with NYS Certified Referees.
- NFHS overtime rules apply. Headgear is highly encouraged.
- Period lengths - Divisions 1, 2, & 3 (1-1-1) Divisions 4, 5, & 6 (1:30, 1:30, 1:30)
- Top 4 in each weight class qualify for the NYWAY Championships on March 14th and 15th at Ithaca College, Ithaca, NY and **MUST** compete at same weight class at the NYWAY States.
- Welcome to all wrestlers residing within Regional boundaries:
Section 7 & 10 schools.
- Weight classes with 5 or fewer wrestlers will wrestle in a round robin format
- **No weight allowance** and must weigh in wearing a singlet.
- If wrestlers do not make the weight they are registered in, they will be moved to the next weight class up, and must compete at the same weight in the NYWAY State Championships.
