**Weigh-Ins:** 6:30-8:00 AM – No satellite, no exceptions; all weigh-ins are Saturday November 14<sup>th</sup> only.

**Admission:** \$7.00 Adult • \$2.00 Children; Children under 3 are free

**Entry Deadline:** Sunday, November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Register online ONLY.

**Rules:** PIAA Rules & Regulations – Periods 1-1-1 OT is :30 sec Neutral 1<sup>st</sup> to score, 2<sup>nd</sup> OT Rideout. First wrestler who scored in regulation gets choice in rideout. Headgear, wrestling shoes and singlets are required. Hairnets are optional.

**Brackets:** This is a Double-Elimination Tourny for all divisions. It will be a 6-man round robin for 6 or less in a division. Wrestlebacks to true second (If you lost the 1<sup>st</sup> match, you can still take second) With going to 6<sup>th</sup> place, most will have at least 3 matches. **TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO COMBINE DIVISION AND WEIGHTS TO PROVIDE MORE WRESTLING OPPORTUNITIES.**

**Awards:**

Novice – Beautiful trophies will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place ranging from 18” down to 6”. Medals will be given for participation.

Open – Large Sculptures will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place. Medals will be given for 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place.

Team Sculptures - will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place. Girls 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup>. This is free of charge, and just for fun, we take your 10 best finishers, and award points to place 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> team points as follows for all divisions: 7-1<sup>st</sup>, 5-2<sup>nd</sup>, 3-3<sup>rd</sup>, 1-4<sup>th</sup>

## **Directions to East Stroudsburg North High School**

### **Directions A –**

**From New York City: Route 80 West through Delaware Water Gap, 2<sup>nd</sup> exit, ex #309 Marshalls Creek, Bushkill; Stay on Route 209 North for 11 miles; Make left on Bushkill Falls Road (11<sup>th</sup> traffic light from Route 80). Go 6.5 miles; make a left at only traffic light; Gymnasium is located on right of high school**

### **Directions B-**

**From Pittsburgh: Rt 80 East to exit 309 Marshalls Creek, Bushkill; Follow directions A**

### **Directions C-**

**From Scranton: Route 84 East to exit 30, Porter's Lake/Blooming Grove; Make a right off of exit. Go 10 miles; Make left of Bushkill Falls Road; go 5 miles to only traffic light on road; Make a right into High School. Gymnasium is located on the right end of the school.**

### **Directions D-**

**From New England and Upstate New York: The last exit in New York is Exit 1; Take 84 West to PA exit 53, Route 209 South Matamoris; stay on 209 South for 26 miles. You will be on 209 through Milford into Delaware State Park. Make right at Bushkill Falls Road; Go 6.5 miles to only traffic light; Make a left; Gymnasium is located on the right end of the school.**

**\*\*I personally drove all of these to get more precise directions. All miles are exact.\*\***
