2018 Lockport Kids Wrestling Tournament Rules:

- ✓ Folkstyle wrestling
- ✓ NY State HS modified rules
- ✓ High School Certified Refs
- ✓ You must select a skill level when registering online:
 - Beginner** – wins less than 30% of their matches or has no experience
 - Average** – wrestler wins 31-59% of their matches
 - Good** – wrestler wins 60-79% of their matches
 - Excellent** – wrestler wins 80% or more of their matches, usually places at tournaments
- ✓ No outside food

Awards: T-shirts for top 3 place finishers, team trophies for top 3 teams (10 scoring wrestlers per team)

Concessions: Food will be served in cafeteria all day

- Skill level and division will be confirmed at time of weigh-in at weigh-in site
- All participants must report to the school and check in by 8 am. Any wrestler that fails to show by 8am will be removed from the brackets
- At 8:15 am all wrestlers will line up around the mats in the main gym in wrestling shoes, singlets, headgear. Certified High School Refs will check skin, hair and nails. If wrestler has braces must have mouth guard. If wrestler has long hair must have a skull cap. If wrestler has a skin condition they must have a note by a Primary Care Physician or dermatologist. Refs and tournament director reserve the right to refuse participation for skin condition such as ring worm, herpes simplex, impetigo, ect. If there is a questionable skin condition – NO NOTE, NO WRESTLING, NO EXCEPTION! Parents need to be responsible and check participant for skin infections prior to arrival and have reviewed by a Primary Care Physician or a dermatologist to be cleared and have note ready. We will not jeopardize the welfare of the other participants.
- After Skin checks refs will review rules with all wrestlers for locking hands, out of bounds, potentially dangerous situations, ect. All rules will follow high school rules, including locking hands. Exception will be overtime. If score is tied after regulation then 1 minute neutral. If still tied whoever scored the 1st point will have choice in 30 second ride-out. If no points scored the choice will be decided by referee flip of coin.
- Coaches meeting at 8:30 am. Wrestling will begin at 9am.

No Smoking on School Grounds. No weapons allowed on school grounds. EMT will be on site. Security will be on site.

- No more than 2 coaches in a corner this will be enforced by refs and security. The mats will be roped off.
- Wrestlers will have weight and Division written on arm
 - Weights may be challenged before start of 2nd round for that bracket.
 - No more than 2 pound allowance from weigh-in weight or wrestler will be forfeited from tournament without a refund. Wrestlers can move up an age division but not down.
- As long as size of bracket allows we will make every effort to group wrestlers based on skill level
 - Skill level can be challenged and if participant selected incorrect skill level during registration that participant can be forfeited from the tournament without a refund – skill level can be confirmed by past tournament results from past 2 years.
- Brackets will be available on trackwrestling.com. Brackets will also be posted on wall and updated throughout tournament. Brackets will be assigned to the same mat all day.

- There will be mat display screens throughout the school showing current bout, warming up and on deck.

Team Award: 10 scoring wrestlers per team. Scoring wrestle must be selected prior to start of 2nd round. Scoring will be done electronically within trackwrestling. Scoring will be same as high school scoring, bonus points awarded for pin and tech.

Entry fee will be charged for everyone – no exception – this includes coaches. Teams will be given 3 meal tickets. Each meal ticket will be good for a free drink and one meal such as a slice of pizza, hot dog, bowl of chili, taco-in-a-bag, ect.
