Category Groups

Age Categories, Start Times & Period Length: A minimum of 20 minutes must be allowed between wrestler's matches, unless agreed upon by the coaches for a shorter time.

Fees

- Registration Fee: \$20 for the first family member, \$14 for the second family member and \$8 for the third family member and subsequent family members.
- Spectator Admission: \$3.00/person. Free for kids 12 & under, Active Military & Coaches with current USA Coaches card.

Registration (No Walk-Ins Allowed)

- Sanctioned USA Clubs may submit tournament registrations at www.usawct.com
- Wrestlers who are not attached to a sanctioned club are requested to contact the nearest sanctioned club to register.
- Out-of-state wrestlers must contact the Tournament Director for registration instructions. The Tournament Director will reply to your email confirming receipt of your registration.
- All registrations must be accompanied with a valid USA Wrestling card number for each listed wrestler. Out-of-state wrestlers may register with the condition that they follow the same rules that USAWCT Clubs follow.
- Last-minute USA Wrestling may be acquired by contacting their Club Director, who must make arrangements with the Membership Director PRIOR to the Wednesday before the tournament.
- Brackets for Girls Division will be made by contact with Tournament Director or identifying such matches during online registration. The female wrestlers may wrestle in the Co-Ed brackets during normal scheduled sessions and in Girls Division as stated above, no extra fee will be charged.
- Pre-registered wrestlers who do not show up for the tournament will be charged the full registration fee. The submitting club is responsible for this fee to be paid the morning of the tournament along with all the other registered wrestlers on the registration form.
- Wrestlers are permitted to register and wrestle in only one (1) bracket per session regardless of staying within their own age group or not.

Code of Conduct

- The Code of Conduct Rules will be strictly enforced. This code of conduct has been established to ensure that there is a defined method for the handling of unacceptable conduct at USAWCT sanctioned wrestling events.
- The code of conduct is described in the document posted on the website (www.usawct.org).

Rules

- All wrestlers with braces on their teeth must have protective mouthguards.
- Head gear will be required for all age groups per USA Wrestling rules.
- Tech Falls occur when a 12 point margin is achieved, this rule applies to all age groups.
- A wrestler can move up one age group with the permission of the tournament director, provided this request is made before bracketing is completed. A wrestler can only compete in one bracket for each session, either the morning or afternoon session. The only division that can wrestle in both morning and afternoon is the Intermediate division, because the wrestler can wrestle in the morning session as an Intermediate and move up one division to Novice for the afternoon session. The coach requesting the division change must show their current coaches card. Therefore, this request cannot be made by anyone without a coach's card.

Notice

- Each Club's Director or designated person for that club will check in with the Tournament Director, inform the Director of any known NO SHOW wrestlers and pay for their team's entry. There are no refunds for no-shows – each club is responsible for full payment.
- All wrestlers must check in by the end of the weigh-in time period to verify they do not have any contagious skin conditions. Wrestlers will not be admitted if they are not checked in on time.
- It is the responsibility of the Club Directors, or the designated person for that club, to check with the head person running the weigh-in area to see if any wrestlers have not checked in by 8:30am for the morning session & 12:30pm for the afternoon session.

Weigh-Ins

- A Madison weight class system will be followed. The maximum weight distribution will be no more than 10%, without coach approval.
- All wrestlers will report for skin-check and weigh-ins before tournament starts. Any wrestler that exceeds the two pound allowance over the registered weight may be disqualified. If the tournament director believes that this was a typo error, the wrestler can be re-bracketed.
- Weight challenges during a tournament are performed at the tournament director's discretion. When a wrestler's weight is challenged by another wrestler (Coach Only), then the challenging wrestler will also be weighed in.
- When weighing-in, each wrestler must weigh-in wearing a competition singlet or shorts.

Food & Concessions

- We will be offering a full assortment of food & drinks.
- There will be no food or drinks allowed in the gym. There will be no exceptions.

Directions

- Exit 11 off of I-84, turn RIGHT at the end of the ramp. Turn LEFT at the next light. Newtown High School is on your LEFT.
- From Route 34 NORTH, Follow to intersection of Route 84. Straight through light. Newtown high School is on your LEFT.
- From Route 25 NORTH, Follow Route 25 North to RIGHT on Wasserman Way. At END of Wasserman Way, take a LEFT, Newtown High School is on your LEFT.
