WRESTLER REGISTRATION

- \$30.00 if registered by 12/31/2024. \$35.00 registration after 12/31/2024
- Online registration at www.wrestlingtournaments.com closes Friday @ 6pm the week of tournament
- Registration limited to first 300 wrestlers
- Wrestler must first register with wrestlingtournaments.com

What is a WARZone Tournament

- Firstly, this is not a madison bracket or double elimination. A WarZone tournament is designed to get your wrestler as many matches against similarly skilled opponents in under 2 hours.
- Your wrestler will arrive at their designated time based on weight; they will weigh-in and matches should commence shortly after weighing in.
- All information your wrestler needs (mat assignment and when they are ready to wrestle) will be provided via text message.
- When the wrestlers match completes, their rating will be adjusted based on how the match ended and they will then be paired with a wrestle with a similar rating for their next match.
- Every wrestler should be able to complete 4+ matches in under 2 hours based on how long they wait between matches

We believe a WARZone tournament is a great way to break-up the long weekends spent at round robin tournaments at schools. From weigh-in to completion of 4-6 matches, wrestlers should be finished in under 2 hours.

The intention of a WARZone is not for an award or placement, it is for your wrestler to get as many quality matches as they are able to in under 2 hours.

BOUTS: Three 1 min. periods; OT 1 min. sudden victory w/30 sec. ride-out. Headgear mandatory

GATE: Adults & coaches \$5; Students \$3; Wrestlers and children under 5 are FREE
